Personal Student Supplies

Please label each of the following items with **First and Last Name**:

These items should be with your child each school day

- 4 set of pocket dividers for binders
- Four 2” Binders (one for each subject area- Language Arts, Math, Science, and History)
- Salt Lake County Library Card (Please add Salt Lake City access if you live in the city)-We encourage you to also download the “Libby” App for free audiobooks!
- Pencil case
 - 24 wooden pencils or 2 mechanical pencils with extra lead

Middle School Language Arts	\$35 per year	Purchasing all class texts (student copies for school and home)
High School Language Arts	\$35 per year	Purchasing all class texts (student copies for school and home)
Art Classes	\$55 per year	Purchase of all specialized supplies
School Play: Wizard of Oz (ALL participating students- those in Theater Electives)	\$50 per year	Purchase of the school license, basic supplies and materials, rental of any costumes that cannot be made at home or put together easily
Farm to Table	\$100* per year	Expendable materials for the course, gardening tools and supplies, greenhouse maintenance
Microeconomy	\$40 per year	Materials and supplies to create product prototypes, business mentorship services, and an administrative fee
Beekeeping Elective	TBD	Purchase of materials for beekeeping
Your True Voice Vocal Training Elective	\$325 per semester	Expert instruction from Debra Bonner- individualized coaching and vocal training
